Each year, T&L offers a selection of assorted dahlias, in a mix of sizes and varieties. One of the most popular blooming tuberous plants, particularly here in the PNW, dahlias will provide magnificent flowers throughout the summer season into the early fall.

As tubers, they are oftentimes not winter hardy, but if they are treated with a little bit of extra care, they can be overwintered and replanted the following year. Each tuber features a number of growing points along the stem (called eyes) and will grow larger and feature more eyes with each passing season.

From large dinnerplate varieties, to smaller, petite sizes, T&L is proud to grow a wide selection of colorful dahlias, perfect for larger gardens and landscapes and smaller gardening spaces.

Series/Type



Anemone Form (Powder-Puff)

Anemone form Dahlias are a specific type of dahlia with a unique flower structure. These dahlias have a dense, fluffy center of tubular florets surrounded by a ring of flat ray petals, resembling anemone flowers. They are smaller and more delicate compared to the dinnerplate or cactus dahlias but add an elegant, intricate texture to gardens and floral arrangements.

Varieties planned for 2025: Rockstar, Take Off, Totally Tangerine



Ball/Pompom

One of the smaller dahlia varieties, Ball or Pompom dahlias are distinct, as they feature globular flower heads, approximately 3" in diameter. Each bloom features an unmistakable arrangement of spiral petals arranged in a perfect spiral. Perfect for borders and containers, they make an excellent cut flower in arrangements.

Varieties planned for 2025: Autumn Pumpkin, Boom Boom White



Cactus/Semi-Cactus

With their unique star shape and spikey petals, Cactus dahlias are the perfect choice for planters and container gardens. Featuring double flowers with long, pointed petals, these blooms come in many different sizes. They stand up well to weather and are sturdier than other dahlia varieties, which can be knocked down and blown about during strong winds or heavy rain.

Dahlegria®

An annual variety, Dahlegria® dahlias are one of the first blooming dahlias. Notable for their small, bright blooms, these plants have dark foliage that offers a remarkable contrast to other annuals in the garden. Makes an excellent addition to the landscape in or containers. Bicolor and white varieties offer great mildew resistance.

Varieties planned for 2025: Apricot Tricolor, Light Rose, Magenta Bicolor, Red



Dahlietta®

A compact, early-blooming series of dahlias bred for small containers, hanging baskets, and borders, Dahlietta dahlias have a bushy, well-branched growth habit and produce abundant flowers throughout the season. As they are easy to grow, they have good disease resistance, and are available in a wide range of colors. They are ideal for containers and small garden spaces.

Varieties planned for 2025: Candy, Emily, Paula, Rachel, Shirley, Tessy



Decorative

With hundreds of different varieties, Decorative dahlias are true knockouts in the garden. Notably, these flowers can be formal (flat and even formation) or informal (generally flat and irregular petal formation). A wide range in height also produces blooms of varying size. When making your selection, it's important to know about the variety you're purchasing to plan for spacing!

Varieties planned for 2025: All That Jazz, American Sunset, Arbatax, Baccara, Berner Oberland, Blue Bell, Senior's Hope, Wine Eyed Jill, Yarra Falls

Dinnerplate

The most spectacular of all dahlias, Dinnerplate varieties are the largest dahlia variety. Often growing to heights of 3-6' and featuring blooms that can be up to nearly 12" in diameter, these are true standouts in any garden.

Varieties planned for 2025: Babylon Purple, Babylon Red, Caribbean Fantasy, Fairway Spur, Seattle



Dreamy

Dreamy dahlias feature deep, almost black foliage that contrasts beautifully with their continuously blooming, vibrant flowers, making them a standout choice for containers, borders, and mixed plantings. With a more compact height, only 12-18", they are ideal for containers and front-of-border plantings.

Varieties planned for 2025: Eyes, Fantasy, Hot Chocolate, Kiss, Morning, Nights



Grandalia™

Grandalia dahlias are a series of compact, bushy dahlias bred for abundant blooms and strong garden performance. They are known for their large, fully double flowers on sturdy stems, making them excellent choices for containers, borders, and patio gardens. As other, smaller varieties, with a more compact height of only 12-18", they are perfect for small spaces.

Varieties planned for 2025: Dark Red, Dark Rose, Fire, Pink Ice, Sunrise, Yellow

LaBella® Maggiore

The largest variety in the LaBella dahlia series, Maggiore are known for their tall, robust growth and large, showy blooms. These dahlias are perfect for borders, larger containers, and landscape plantings, offering a bold display of color throughout the growing season. Available in a variety of colors, these varieties are immensely popular!

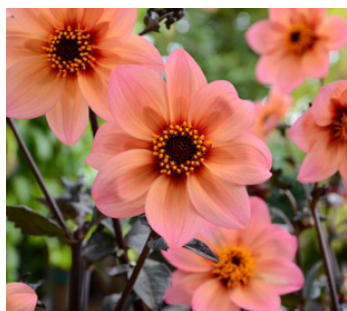
Varieties planned for 2025: Flame, Purple, Rose, White



LaBella® Medio Fun

Part of the LaBella® series, known for their compact growth, vibrant colors, and continuous blooms throughout the season, the Medio category falls between the Mini and Grande series, making these dahlias a perfect balance of medium-sized plants and showy flowers. With blooms 3-4" wide and a full, double-petal structure, the "Fun" series features bold, multi-tone petals that create a lively look. With blooms from early summer until frost (with proper care), they work well in patio pots, hanging baskets, and flower beds.

Varieties planned for 2025: Gold Eye, Pink Eye, Violet Flame, White, Yellow Blush



Mystic™

A striking series of dark-leaved, single-flowered dahlias, known for their deep, almost black foliage and vibrant, open-faced blooms that attract pollinators, these dahlias are excellent for borders, containers, and pollinator-friendly gardens. Typically 18-24" tall, their bright blooms with dark foliage create a dramatic contrast in containers and mixed plantings.

Varieties planned for 2025: Fantasy, Wizard

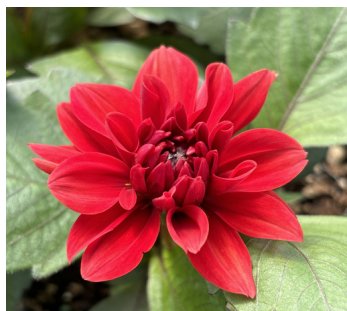

Peony-Flowering (Peony-Type)

Peony-Flowering dahlias (also known as Peony-Type dahlias) are a unique dahlia form characterized by open, semi-double flowers with a prominent central disc surrounded by multiple layers of broad, slightly ruffled petals. Their loose, airy appearance resembles peonies, making them a great choice for cottage gardens, pollinator-friendly plantings, and floral arrangements. Our variety, 'Fascination', is most well known for its vibrant pink flowers and deep bronze leaves.

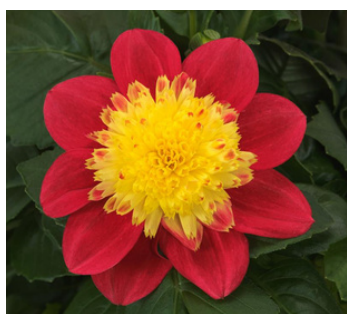

Revelation

Revelation dahlias, developed by Dümmer Orange, are renowned for their large, semi-double blooms, robust growth, and suitability for both large containers and landscape plantings. Each variety in this series showcases vibrant colors and sturdy stems, making them a favorite among gardeners and landscapers.

Varieties planned for 2025: Red, Salmon Bicolor



Venti™

Venti dahlias are a series of large, vigorous dahlias bred for strong branching, large blooms, and continuous flowering. They are particularly well-suited for containers, borders, and landscaping, offering a bigger presence compared to more compact dahlia varieties. As they are strong and well-branched, there is less need for staking compared to taller varieties. However, due to their unique appearance, they are less pollinator friendly than other dahlia varieties, although they still attract some bee and butterfly attention. The FireBurst and PinkBurst varieties are particularly striking due to their unique two-tone effect, large blooms, and open-centered appearance.

Waterlily

Waterlily Dahlias are a unique dahlia form known for their graceful, symmetrical blooms that resemble waterlily flowers. These dahlias have broad, slightly cupped petals that form a shallow, open bloom, giving them an elegant and soft appearance. They are prized for their delicate look, strong stems, and excellent performance in gardens and floral arrangements.

Varieties planned for 2025: Yvonne



Dahlia x hybrida

Dahlia x hybrida 'Sincerity' is a striking dahlia cultivar renowned for its large, fully double blooms that can reach over ~8" in diameter. The flowers display a captivating pink and white bicolor pattern with a touch of yellow at the center, making them a standout addition to any garden or container arrangement.

With its' bold and beautiful blooms, this compact, tender dahlia produces blooms from mid summer into mid fall.
